

Druk Research & Education Network (DrukREN) Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

1. Acceptable Use

- 1.1. A generally accepted principle within the DrukREN community is to keep the network as open as possible.
- 1.2. All network use by Druk Research & Education Network (DrukREN) members shall be for, or in support of, research and education.

2. Unacceptable Use

- 2.1. It is not acceptable to use the DrukREN for purposes which violate the law of Bhutan.
- 2.2. It is not acceptable to use the DrukREN for any purpose which violates the intellectual property rights of others.
- 2.3. It is not acceptable to use the DrukREN in a manner that intentionally or negligently disrupts normal network use and service. Such disruption would include the intentional or negligent propagation of computer viruses, the violation of personal privacy, and the unauthorized access to protected and private network resources.

3. Enforcement of Policy

- 3.1. Each DrukREN member must make reasonable efforts to publicize the policies of DrukREN.
- 3.2. Reported and perceived violations of the Acceptable Use Policy will be reviewed by the Government Technology (GovTech) Agency, Royal Government of Bhutan. Violations that are not promptly remedied by the member institution may result in action including the suspension or termination of DrukREN's service.

4. Modification of Policy

- 4.1. GovTech Agency reserves the right to modify this AUP (and its posted guidelines or other rules) from time to time. Advance notice will be provided for any such modifications.
